Fact Sheet

Members of the Chesapeake Flying Club will be part of the annual Tangier Island Holly Run at Bay Bridge airport on December 3, 2016. The Flying Club is a sponsor of the Pilot's breakfast held at Bay Bridge Airport before the flight to Tangier Island.

- ✈️ The club is a non-profit group for pilots to share the cost of owning and flying an airplane.
- ✈️ Pilot members buy a share of the plane (refundable) and pay modest monthly dues to cover insurance and other costs.
- ✈️ Plane usage is \$55/hour, which is much less than owning an airplane or renting from local flight schools.
- ✈️ The plane is available for overnight and long trips, providing more flexibility than renting from local flight schools
- ✈️ The Chesapeake Flying Club owns a Tecnam Eaglet, which is a modern, two person aircraft.

Part of the club's purpose is to share the joy of aviation with the local community in events such as the Tangier Island Holly Run.
